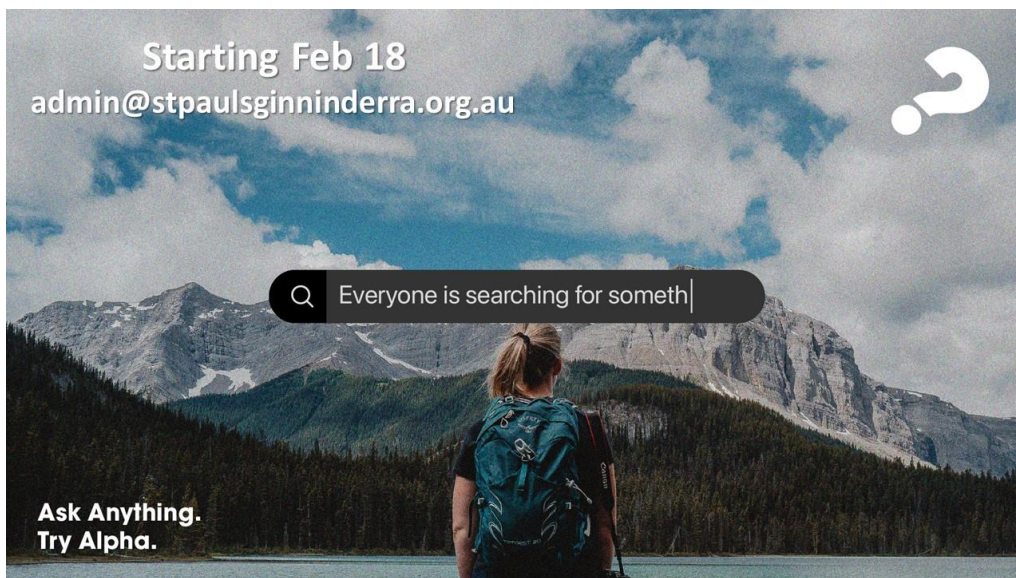


Sunday Feb 6th there will be an opportunity to contribute to the 2021 National Church Life Survey which

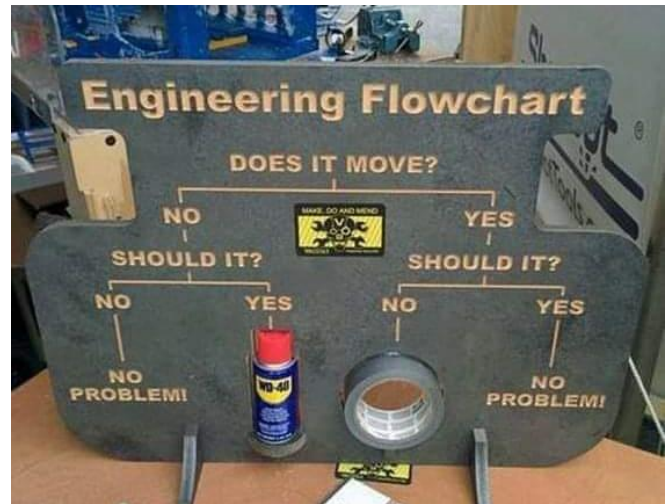

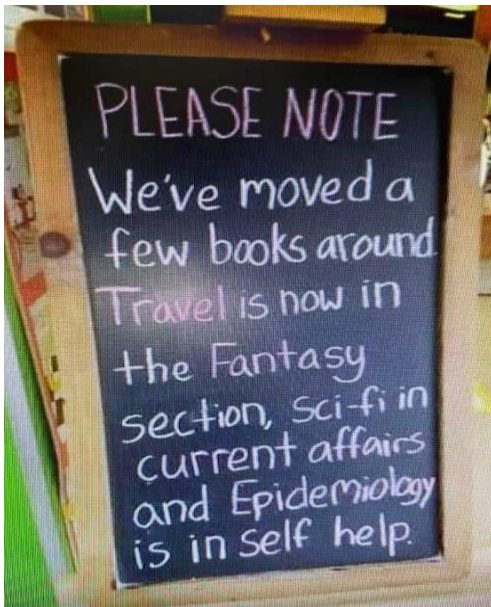
